- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 39.004 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 39.004. TEXAS ENERGY PLAN. (a) In consultation with
- 8 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, the Railroad
- 9 Commission of Texas, the independent organization certified under
- 10 Section 39.151, the Texas Water Development Board, and
- 11 representatives of the academic community involved with state
- 12 university energy programs, the commission shall develop a plan to
- 13 maximize the use of energy resources of this state for the
- 14 generation of electricity in the ERCOT region.
- 15 (b) The plan must:
- 16 (1) recognize and encourage the competitive market
- 17 structure in ERCOT;
- 18 (2) encourage investments in energy resources and
- 19 development of jobs in this state;
- 20 (3) encourage the development of a diverse portfolio
- 21 of clean, reliable, and competitively priced energy sources in this
- 22 state;

- 23 (4) promote research, pilot projects, and
- 24 market-based incentives to explore and expand long-term energy

- 1 options; and
- 2 (5) account for the statewide and regional water
- 3 planning process and means to reduce the use of water resources in
- 4 <u>electric generation</u>.
- 5 (c) The agencies and entities identified by Subsection (a)
- 6 shall use existing available resources to develop the plan.
- 7 (d) The commission shall submit the plan to the legislature
- 8 not later than December 31, 2018.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
