3	the current condition of a system's infrastructure to the Texas

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 13.150 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 13.150. SEWER UTILITY SERVICE SYSTEM REPORT. (a) A
9	retail public utility that provides sewer utility service shall
10	report to the commission the current condition of the utility's
11	sewer system.
12	(b) The retail public utility must report to the commission
13	not later than the 10th anniversary of the date the utility last
14	filed a report under this section.
15	(c) The report must rate the condition of all sewer
16	collection infrastructure components of the system in accordance
17	with commission rules as:
18	(1) functioning without signs of deterioration or
19	leaks and in a good condition that requires no repairs;
20	(2) needing minor repairs to restore minor damage or
21	to fix leaks or cracks;
22	(3) needing to be rehabilitated to restore lost
23	structural integrity soon or to fix active leaks and cracks
24	allowing inflow and outflow; or

1	(4) requiring a full replacement because the system
2	component is near to or in a condition of failure.
3	(d) The condition assignment described by Subsection (c)
4	must be signed by:
5	(1) an engineer; and
6	(2) the governing body of the retail public utility.
7	(e) The commission shall compile information from the
8	report required by this section and post the information on the
9	commission's Internet website.
10	SECTION 2. A retail public utility, as defined by Section
11	13.002, Water Code, that provides sewer utility service must submit
12	the initial report required by Section 13.150, Water Code, as added
13	by this Act, on or before December 1, 2018.
14	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
15	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
16	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
17	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
18	Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
