A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the dissolution of the Angelina County Water Control
- 3 and Improvement District No. 3 and the territory of the Angelina
- 4 County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. (a) Beginning on the effective date of this Act,
- 7 the directors of the Angelina County Water Control and Improvement
- 8 District No. 3 shall wind up the affairs of the district.
- 9 (b) On the 30th day after the effective date of this Act:
- 10 (1) the Angelina County Water Control and Improvement
- 11 District No. 3 is dissolved;
- 12 (2) the terms of the directors of the district expire;
- 13 and

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- 14 (3) all assets and liabilities of the district are
- 15 transferred to the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No.
- 16 1.
- 17 SECTION 2. Subtitle B, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
- 18 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 6918 to read as follows:
- 19 CHAPTER 6918. ANGELINA COUNTY FRESH WATER SUPPLY DISTRICT NO. 1;
- 20 <u>TERRITORY</u>
- 21 Sec. 6918.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district"
- 22 means the Angelina County Fresh Water Supply District No. 1.
- Sec. 6918.002. ADDITIONAL TERRITORY. On September 1, 2017,
- 24 the territory of the former Angelina County Water Control and

- 1 Improvement District No. 3, as that territory existed on August 31,
- 2 2017, is added to the territory of the district.
- 3 SECTION 3. Before the 30th day after the effective date of
- 4 this Act, the board of directors of the Angelina County Water
- 5 Control and Improvement District No. 3 may select from the members
- 6 serving on the board on the date of the selection one member to
- 7 serve as a nonvoting member of the board of the Angelina County
- 8 Fresh Water Supply District No. 1 from the date of the selection
- 9 until the next election of directors for the Angelina County Fresh
- 10 Water Supply District No. 1.
- 11 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 12 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 13 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 14 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 15 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 16 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 17 Government Code.
- 18 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 19 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 20 Environmental Quality.
- 21 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 22 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 23 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 24 representatives within the required time.
- 25 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 26 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 27 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled

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- 1 and accomplished.
- 2 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
