5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle C, Title 4, Special District Local Laws
7	Code, is amended by adding Chapter 3795 to read as follows:
8	CHAPTER 3795. LIBERTY COUNTY MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT DISTRICT NO. 1
9	SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS
10	Sec. 3795.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
11	(1) "Board" means the district's board of directors.
12	(2) "City" means the City of Plum Grove, Texas.
13	(3) "Commission" means the Texas Commission on
14	Environmental Quality.
15	(4) "County" means Liberty County.
16	(5) "Director" means a board member.
17	(6) "District" means the Liberty County Municipal
18	Management District No. 1.
19	Sec. 3795.002. CREATION AND NATURE OF DISTRICT. The
20	district is a special district created under Sections 52 and 52-a,
21	Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution.
22	Sec. 3795.003. PURPOSE; LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS. (a) The
23	creation of the district is essential to accomplish the purposes of
24	Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,

Texas Constitution, and other public purposes stated in this 1 2 chapter. By creating the district and in authorizing the city and other political subdivisions to contract with the district, the 3 legislature has established a program to accomplish the public 4 purposes set out in Section 52-a, Article III, Texas Constitution. 5 6 (b) The creation of the district is necessary to promote, 7 develop, encourage, and maintain employment, commerce, transportation, housing, tourism, recreation, the 8 arts, entertainment, economic development, safety, and the public 9 10 welfare in the district. (c) This chapter and the creation of the district may not be 11 12 interpreted to relieve the city or the county from providing the level of services provided as of the effective date of the Act 13 14 enacting this chapter to the area in the district. The district is 15 created to supplement and not to supplant city or county services 16 provided in the district. Sec. 3795.004. FINDINGS OF BENEFIT AND PUBLIC PURPOSE. (a) 17

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The district is created to serve a public use and benefit.
(b) All land and other property included in the district
will benefit from the improvements and services to be provided by
the district under powers conferred by Sections 52 and 52-a,
Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and
other powers granted under this chapter.

(c) The district is created to accomplish the purposes of a
 municipal management district as provided by general law and
 Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and Section 59, Article XVI,
 Texas Constitution.

H.B. No. 4341 1 (d) The creation of the district is in the public interest 2 and is essential to further the public purposes of: 3 (1) developing and diversifying the economy of the 4 state; 5 (2) eliminating unemployment and underemployment; and 6 (3) developing or expanding transportation and 7 commerce. 8 (e) The district will: 9 (1) promote the health, safety, and general welfare of residents, employers, potential employees, employees, visitors, 10 and consumers in the district, and of the public; 11 (2) provide needed funding for the district to 12 preserve, maintain, and enhance the economic health and vitality of 13 14 the district territory as a community and business center; and 15 (3) promote the health, safety, welfare, and enjoyment of the public by providing pedestrian ways and by landscaping and 16 17 developing certain areas in the district, which are necessary for the restoration, preservation, and enhancement of scenic beauty. 18 19 (f) Pedestrian ways along or across a street, whether at grade or above or below the surface, and street lighting, street 20 landscaping, parking, and street art objects are parts of and 21 22 necessary components of a street and are considered to be a street 23 or road improvement. 24 (g) The district will not act as the agent or instrumentality of any private interest even though the district 25 26 will benefit many private interests as well as the public. Sec. 3795.005. INITIAL DISTRICT TERRITORY. (a) 27 The

H.B. No. 4341 district is initially composed of the territory described by 1 2 Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter. 3 (b) The boundaries and field notes contained in Section 2 of the Act enacting this chapter form a closure. A mistake in the 4 5 field notes or in copying the field notes in the legislative process does not affect the district's: 6 7 (1) organization, existence, or validity; 8 (2) right to contract; 9 (3) authority to borrow money or issue bonds or other obligations described by Section 3795.204 or to pay the principal 10 and interest of the bonds or other obligations; 11 12 (4) right to impose or collect an assessment or collect other revenue; or 13 14 (5) legality or operation. Sec. 3795.006. APPLICABILITY OF MUNICIPAL MANAGEMENT 15 DISTRICT LAW. Except as provided by this chapter, Chapter 375, 16 17 Local Government Code, applies to the district. Sec. 3795.007. CONSTRUCTION OF CHAPTER. This chapter shall 18 19 be liberally construed in conformity with the findings and purposes stated in this chapter. 20 21 SUBCHAPTER B. BOARD OF DIRECTORS Sec. 3795.051. GOVERNING BODY; TERMS. (a) The district is 22 governed by a board of five voting directors who must be qualified 23 24 under Section 375.063, Local Government Code. (b) The directors serve staggered terms of four years with 25 26 two or three directors' terms expiring June 1 of each odd-numbered 27 year.

1	Sec. 3795.052. APPOINTMENT OF DIRECTORS. The commission
2	shall appoint directors from persons recommended by the board.
3	Sec. 3795.053. VACANCY. If a vacancy occurs on the board,
4	the remaining directors shall appoint a director for the remainder
5	of the unexpired term.
6	Sec. 3795.054. COMPENSATION; EXPENSES. (a) The district
7	may compensate each director in an amount not to exceed \$50 for each
8	board meeting. The total amount of compensation a director may
9	receive each year may not exceed \$2,000.
10	(b) A director is entitled to reimbursement for necessary
11	and reasonable expenses incurred in carrying out the duties and
12	responsibilities of the board.

2	Sec. 3795.104. FIREFIGHTING SERVICES. Notwithstanding
3	Section 49.351(a), Water Code, the district may, as authorized by
4	Section 59(f), Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Section 49.351,
5	Water Code:
6	(1) establish, operate, and maintain a fire
7	department;
8	(2) contract with another political subdivision for
9	the joint operation of a fire department; or
10	(3) contract with any other person to perform
11	firefighting services in the district and may issue bonds and
12	impose taxes to pay for the department and the activities.
13	Sec. 3795.105. FEES AND CHARGES. (a) The district may
14	adopt and enforce all necessary charges, mandatory fees, or
15	rentals, in addition to taxes, for providing or making available
16	any district facility or service, including firefighting
17	activities provided under Section 3795.104.
18	(b) To enforce payment of an unpaid fee or charge due to the
19	district, on the request of the district, a retail public utility,
20	as defined by Section 13.002, Water Code, providing water or sewer
21	service to a customer in the district shall terminate the service.
22	Sec. 3795.106. NO EMINENT DOMAIN POWER. The district may
23	not exercise the power of eminent domain.
24	SUBCHAPTER D. GENERAL FINANCIAL PROVISIONS
25	Sec. 3795.151. DISBURSEMENTS AND TRANSFERS OF MONEY. The
26	board by resolution shall establish the number of signatures and
27	the procedure required for a disbursement or transfer of the

1 district's money.

Sec. 3795.152. MONEY USED FOR IMPROVEMENTS OR SERVICES.
 The district may acquire, construct, finance, operate, or maintain
 an improvement project or service authorized under this chapter or
 Chapter 375, Local Government Code, using any money available to
 the district.

Sec. 3795.153. PETITION REQUIRED FOR FINANCING SERVICES AND
 IMPROVEMENTS WITH ASSESSMENTS. (a) The board may not finance a
 service or improvement project with assessments under this chapter
 unless a written petition requesting that service or improvement
 has been filed with the board.

12 (b) A petition filed under Subsection (a) must be signed by 13 the owners of a majority of the assessed value of real property in 14 the district subject to assessment according to the most recent 15 certified tax appraisal roll for the county.

16 Sec. 3795.154. METHOD OF NOTICE OF HEARING. The district 17 may mail the notice required by Section 375.115(c), Local 18 Government Code, by certified or first class United States mail. 19 The board shall determine the method of mailing notice.

20 <u>Sec. 3795.155.</u> ASSESSMENTS; LIENS FOR ASSESSMENTS. (a) 21 <u>The board by resolution may impose and collect an assessment for any</u> 22 <u>purpose authorized by this chapter in all or any part of the</u> 23 <u>district.</u>

24 (b) An assessment, a reassessment, or an assessment 25 resulting from an addition to or correction of the assessment roll 26 by the district, penalties and interest on an assessment or 27 reassessment, an expense of collection, and reasonable attorney's

1	fees incurred by the district:
2	(1) are a first and prior lien against the property
3	assessed;
4	(2) are superior to any other lien or claim other than
5	a lien or claim for county, school district, or municipal ad valorem
6	taxes; and
7	(3) are the personal liability of and a charge against
8	the owners of the property even if the owners are not named in the
9	assessment proceedings.
10	(c) The lien is effective from the date of the board's
11	resolution imposing the assessment until the date the assessment is
12	paid. The board may enforce the lien in the same manner that the
13	board may enforce an ad valorem tax lien against real property.
14	(d) The board may make a correction to or deletion from the
15	assessment roll that does not increase the amount of assessment of
16	any parcel of land without providing notice and holding a hearing in
17	the manner required for additional assessments.
18	SUBCHAPTER E. TAXES AND BONDS
19	Sec. 3795.201. ELECTIONS REGARDING TAXES AND BONDS. (a)
20	The district may issue, without an election, bonds, notes, and
21	other obligations secured by revenue other than ad valorem taxes.
22	(b) The district must hold an election in the manner
23	provided by Subchapter L, Chapter 375, Local Government Code, to
24	obtain voter approval before the district may impose an ad valorem
25	tax or issue bonds payable from ad valorem taxes.
26	(c) The district may not issue bonds payable from ad valorem
27	taxes to finance a road project unless the issuance is approved by a

1	vote of a two-thirds majority of the district voters voting at an
2	election held for that purpose.
3	Sec. 3795.202. OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE TAX. (a) If
4	authorized by a majority of the district voters voting at an
5	election held in accordance with Section 3795.201, the district may
6	impose an operation and maintenance tax on taxable property in the
7	district in accordance with Section 49.107, Water Code, for
8	operation and maintenance purposes, including for:
9	(1) maintaining and operating the district;
10	(2) planning, constructing, acquiring, maintaining,
11	repairing, and operating all improvement projects, including land,
12	plants, works, facilities, improvements, appliances, and equipment
13	of the district; or
14	(3) paying costs of services, engineering and legal
15	fees, and organization and administrative expenses.
16	(b) The board shall determine the tax rate. The rate may not
17	exceed the rate approved at the election.
18	Sec. 3795.203. SALES AND USE TAX. (a) The district may
19	impose a sales and use tax if authorized by a majority of the voters
20	of the district voting at an election called for that purpose.
21	Revenue from the tax may be used for any purpose for which ad
22	valorem tax revenue of the district may be used.
23	(b) The district may not adopt a sales and use tax if as a
24	result of the adoption of the tax the combined rate of all sales and
25	use taxes imposed by the district and other political subdivisions
26	of this state having territory in the district would exceed two
27	percent at any location in the district.

1 (c) If the voters of the district approve the adoption of a sales and use tax at an election held on the same election date on 2 which another political subdivision adopts a sales and use tax or 3 approves an increase in the rate of its sales and use tax and as a 4 5 result the combined rate of all sales and use taxes imposed by the district and other political subdivisions of this state having 6 7 territory in the district would exceed two percent at any location 8 in the district, the election to adopt a sales and use tax under this chapter has no effect. 9 (d) Chapter 321, Tax Code, applies to the imposition, 10 computation, administration, enforcement, and collection of the 11 12 sales and use tax imposed by this section except to the extent it is inconsistent with this chapter. 13

14 <u>Sec. 3795.204. AUTHORITY TO BORROW MONEY AND TO ISSUE BONDS</u>
15 <u>AND OTHER OBLIGATIONS. (a) The district may borrow money on terms</u>
16 <u>determined by the board.</u>

17 (b) The district may issue bonds, notes, or other 18 obligations payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, 19 assessments, impact fees, revenue, contract payments, grants, or 20 other district money, or any combination of those sources of money, 21 to pay for any authorized district purpose.

22 <u>Sec. 3795.205. TAXES FOR BONDS. At the time the district</u> 23 <u>issues bonds payable wholly or partly from ad valorem taxes, the</u> 24 <u>board shall provide for the annual imposition of a continuing</u> 25 <u>direct annual ad valorem tax, without limit as to rate or amount,</u> 26 <u>for each year that all or part of the bonds are outstanding as</u> 27 required and in the manner provided by Sections 54.601 and 54.602,

1 Water Code.

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2 <u>Sec. 3795.206. BONDS FOR ROAD PROJECTS. At the time of</u> 3 <u>issuance, the total principal amount of bonds or other obligations</u> 4 <u>issued or incurred to finance road projects and payable from ad</u> 5 <u>valorem taxes may not exceed one-fourth of the assessed value of the</u> 6 <u>real property in the district.</u>

8 <u>Sec. 3795.251. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies to</u> 9 <u>bonds payable wholly or partly from revenue derived from</u> 10 <u>assessments on real property in the district.</u>

SUBCHAPTER F. SPECIAL BOND PROVISIONS

Sec. 3795.252. CONFLICT OF LAWS. In the event of a conflict between this subchapter and any other law, this subchapter prevails.

Sec. 3795.253. WRITTEN AGREEMENT REGARDING 14 SPECIAL 15 APPRAISALS. Before an election may be held on the question of issuing bonds, including an election that combines the question of 16 17 confirming the creation of the district with the question of authorizing the district to issue bonds, the district and any 18 19 person to whom the board intends that proceeds of the bonds be distributed, including the developer, another owner of land in the 20 district, and any entity acting as a lender to the developer or 21 other landowner for the purpose of a project relating to the 22 23 district, must enter into a written agreement that:

24 (1) waives for the term of the agreement the right to a
25 special appraisal with respect to taxation by the district under
26 Subchapters B, C, D, E, F, and H, Chapter 23, Tax Code; and

27 (2) remains in effect for 30 years and is binding on

1	the parties, on entities related to or affiliated with the parties,
2	and on their successors and assignees.
3	Sec. 3795.254. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADVERTISING BOND ISSUE. A
4	district may not advertise for an issuance of bonds until the
5	completion of at least 25 percent of the projected value of the
6	improvements, including houses and other buildings, that are liable
7	for district assessments and necessary to support the district
8	bonds.
9	Sec. 3795.255. REQUIREMENTS FOR BOND ISSUE. The district
10	may not issue bonds until:
11	(1) the district submits to the commission:
12	(A) an engineer's report describing the project
13	for which the bonds will provide funding, including data, profiles,
14	maps, plans, and specifications related to the project; and
15	(B) a cash flow analysis to determine the
16	projected rate of assessment, which includes the following
17	assumptions:
18	(i) each ending balance for debt service in
19	the analysis is not less than 25 percent of the following year's
20	debt service requirement;
21	(ii) interest income is only shown on the
22	ending balance for debt service for the first two years; and
23	(iii) the projected rate of assessment is
24	level or decreasing for the life of the bonds issued by the
25	district;
26	(2) the completion of at least 75 percent of the
27	projected value of the improvements, including houses and other

1	buildings, that are liable for district assessments and necessary
2	to support the district bonds; and
3	(3) the district has obtained an independent market
4	study from a firm recognized in the area of real estate market
5	analysis supporting the development projects for the real property
6	that is liable for district assessments and necessary to support
7	the district bonds.
8	Sec. 3795.256. REQUIREMENTS FOR COLLECTION OF REVENUE TO
9	PAY BONDS. The district may not collect an assessment to be used
10	for the payment of bonds until:
11	(1) the completion of at least 95 percent of the
12	underground water, wastewater, and drainage facilities financed
13	from bond proceeds that are necessary to serve the projected
14	build-out, as certified by the district's engineer;
15	(2) the district or other appropriate party has
16	secured the groundwater, surface water, and water discharge permits
17	that are necessary to secure capacity to support the projected
18	<pre>build-out;</pre>
19	(3) the completion of at least 95 percent of lift
20	station, water plant, and sewage treatment plant capacity
21	sufficient to serve the connections constructed in the project for
22	a period of not less than 18 months, as certified by the district's
23	engineer; and
24	(4) the completion of at least 95 percent of the
25	streets and roads that are necessary to provide access to the areas
26	served by utilities and financed by the proceeds of bonds issued by
27	the district, as certified by the district's engineer and

## 1 constructed in accordance with municipal or county standards.

1 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to 2 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this 3 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a 4 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies, 5 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished 6 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313, 7 Government Code.

8 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has 9 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on 10 Environmental Quality.

(c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the house of representatives within the required time.

15 (d) The general law relating to consent by political 16 subdivisions to the creation of districts with conservation, 17 reclamation, and road powers and the inclusion of land in those 18 districts has been complied with.

(e) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act have been fulfilled and accomplished.

23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
