CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, United Nations Agenda 21 is a comprehensive plan
2 that promotes environmental extremism and social engineering; and

3 WHEREAS, Initiated at the United Nations Conference on
4 Environment and Development held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, in
5 1992, Agenda 21 pushes so-called "sustainable development" that
6 would be implemented at the expense of private property ownership,
7 single-family homes, and individual transportation choices; and

8 WHEREAS, This pernicious agenda is being advanced in
9 communities across the United States by ICLEI—Local Governments for
10 Sustainability, which supports such programs as "Smart Growth
11 America," "Resilient Cities," and other "green" projects; and

12 WHEREAS, Through Agenda 21, the United Nations is attempting
13 to exert an anticapitalist influence on American communities;
14 although the agenda has no binding force on the federal government
15 or on any state or local government, it is vital that all agencies,
16 entities, and governments remain vigilant about its radical
17 policies and reject its implementation outright; now, therefore, be

19 RESOLVED, That the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas
20 hereby express its opposition to United Nations Agenda 21; and, be
21 it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
23 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
24 the president of the Senate and speaker of the House of
