7 WHEREAS, SMA was originally founded as the Texas Warehouse 8 and Transfermen's Association at a meeting held in Fort Worth in 9 August 1917; the meeting was organized by S. J. Westheimer of 10 Houston, who went on to serve as the organization's first 11 president; and

12 WHEREAS, In 1934, the group became known as the Southwest 13 Warehouse and Transfer Association to reflect its expansion to the 14 surrounding states of Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and New 15 Mexico, and its regional responsibilities continued until 2001, 16 when Texas again became its sole focus; in 1978, the association's 17 offices were moved from Dallas to Austin, and its name was changed 18 to the Southwest Movers Association in 1995; and

WHEREAS, Although state and federal laws have evolved with the passing years, the protection of the consumer public, through licensing and insurance regulations, has been and continues to be a core part of the SMA mission; and

23 WHEREAS, Over the past 100 years, the Southwest Movers 24 Association has worked diligently to promote and support the moving
