1-17 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1-18 WHEREAS, For too long, Congress has proven itself fiscally
 1-19 irresponsible and has created a crushing national debt through
 1-20 improvident and imprudent spending; and

1-21 WHEREAS, The deleterious effect of this fiscal mismanagement
 1-22 on our economy and the strength of our nation is ongoing and the
 1-23 consequences of inaction are severe; and

1-24 WHEREAS, Setting a federal budget is an essential aspect of
 1-25 governing, and Congress must accept its responsibility to regularly
 1-26 pass a budget bill; now, therefore, be it

1-27 RESOLVED, That the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas
 1-28 hereby respectfully urge the Congress of the United States to pass a
 1-29 budget; and, be it further

1-30 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
 1-31 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
 1-32 the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of
 1-33 Representatives of the United States Congress, and to all the
 1-34 members of the Texas delegation to Congress with the request that
 1-35 this resolution be officially entered into the Congressional Record
 1-36 as a memorial to the Congress of the United States of America.
