CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Throughout the Obama administration, the federal

2 government waged a campaign of overregulation that caused

3 significant harm to the oil and gas industry in the Lone Star State;

4 and

5 WHEREAS, Despite protests from Texas and other oil- and

6 gas-producing states, the U.S. government has implemented a litany

7 of massive federal regulations, resulting in an unnavigable network

8 of rules and guidelines that has produced greater economic hardship

9 but insignificant environmental benefits; such policies have led

10 the State of Texas to join with many other oil- and gas-producing

11 states in filing more than 20 lawsuits against federal overreach;

12 and

WHEREAS, A flourishing oil and gas industry in Texas is vital

14 to our nation's energy independence from foreign and hostile energy

15 cartels; it is paramount that the federal government transcend

16 partisan politics and stop misusing regulatory power and instead

17 work with Texas to create better energy policies that will

18 strengthen our economy, provide more good-paying jobs, and enhance

19 our national security; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the 85th Legislature of the State of Texas

21 hereby urge Congress and the executive branch of the federal

22 government to identify key federal regulations currently under the

23 authority of the Environmental Protection Agency, the U.S.

24 Department of the Interior, the U.S. Department of Energy, or other

- 1 federal agencies, to determine whether they should be preserved,
- 2 revised, delegated to state agencies, or eliminated; and, be it
- 3 further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Texas Legislature encourage Congress and
- 5 the executive branch of the federal government to work in
- 6 conjunction with Texas on delegating the authority of federal
- 7 energy regulations to the state's regulatory agencies, in an effort
- 8 to mitigate the overregulation of the oil and gas industry in the
- 9 Lone Star State; and, be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That the Texas secretary of state forward official
- 11 copies of this resolution to the president of the United States, to
- 12 the speaker of the House of Representatives and to the president of
- 13 the Senate of the United States Congress, and to all members of the
- 14 Texas delegation to Congress with the request that this resolution
- 15 be officially entered in the Congressional Record as a memorial to
- 16 the Congress of the United States of America.
