1 WHEREAS, Proud members of the Texas Cattle Feeders
2 Association are celebrating the organization's 50th anniversary in
3 2017; and

4 WHEREAS, A national leader in animal care and health, food
5 safety, environmental stewardship, and trade policy, TCFA works to
6 advance the economic, political, and social interests of the cattle
7 feeding industry in Texas, Oklahoma, and New Mexico; and

8 WHEREAS, The area served by TCFA is the largest
9 cattle-feeding region in the United States, feeding and marketing
10 approximately 6 million head of cattle each year and producing 28
11 percent of the nation's fed-cattle supply; and

12 WHEREAS, In the past 50 years, TCFA-area feed yards have fed
13 and marketed some 275 million head of cattle, which produced
14 roughly 125 billion pounds of beef, or the equivalent of 500 billion
15 quarter-pound hamburgers; and

17 across the country and around the world, and the annual economic
18 impact of cattle feeding on the State of Texas alone is in the
19 billions of dollars; and
