A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment relating to the appropriation
- 2 of the net revenue received from the imposition of the state sales
- 3 and use tax on sporting goods.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 7-d to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7-d. (a) For each state fiscal year, the net revenue
- 8 received from the collection of any state taxes imposed on the sale,
- 9 storage, or use of sporting goods that were subject to taxation on
- 10 January 1, 2017, under Chapter 151, Tax Code, is automatically
- 11 appropriated when received to the Parks and Wildlife Department and
- 12 the Texas Historical Commission, or their successors in function,
- 13 and is allocated between those agencies as provided by general law.
- 14 The legislature by general law may provide limitations on the use of
- 15 money appropriated under this subsection.
- 16 (b) In this section, "sporting goods" means an item of
- 17 tangible personal property designed and sold for use in a sport or
- 18 sporting activity, excluding apparel and footwear except that which
- 19 is suitable only for use in a sport or sporting activity, and
- 20 excluding board games, electronic games and similar devices,
- 21 aircraft and powered vehicles, and replacement parts and
- 22 <u>accessories for any excluded item.</u>
- 23 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 24 the Texas Constitution:

- 1 TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 2 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature,
- 3 Regular Session, 2017, requiring the automatic appropriation of the
- 4 net revenue received from the collection of state taxes imposed on
- 5 the sale, storage, or use of certain sporting goods to the Parks and
- 6 Wildlife Department and the Texas Historical Commission.
- 7 (b) Section 7-d, Article VIII, of this constitution takes
- 8 effect September 1, 2019, and applies only to state tax revenues
- 9 that are collected on or after that date.
- 10 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2020.
- 11 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 13 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 14 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring the
- 15 automatic appropriation of the net revenue received from the
- 16 collection of state taxes imposed on the sale, storage, or use of
- 17 certain sporting goods to the Parks and Wildlife Department and the
- 18 Texas Historical Commission."
