## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more political
- 3 subdivisions of this state a person's inventory held for sale at
- 4 retail.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1(d), Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The Legislature by general law shall exempt from ad
- 9 valorem taxation household goods not held or used for the
- 10 production of income and personal effects not held or used for the
- 11 production of income. The Legislature by general law may exempt
- 12 from ad valorem taxation:
- 13 (1) all or part of the personal property homestead of a
- 14 family or single adult, "personal property homestead" meaning that
- 15 personal property exempt by law from forced sale for debt;
- 16 (2) subject to Subsections (e) and (g) of this section
- 17 and except as provided by Section 1-p of this article, all other
- 18 tangible personal property, except structures which are
- 19 substantially affixed to real estate and are used or occupied as
- 20 residential dwellings and except property held or used for the
- 21 production of income;
- 22 (3) subject to Subsection (e) of this section, a
- 23 leased motor vehicle that is not held primarily for the production
- 24 of income by the lessee and that otherwise qualifies under general

- 1 law for exemption; and
- 2 (4) one motor vehicle, as defined by general law,
- 3 owned by an individual that is used in the course of the
- 4 individual's occupation or profession and is also used for personal
- 5 activities of the owner that do not involve the production of
- 6 income.
- 7 SECTION 2. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-p to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1-p. The legislature by general law may exempt from ad
- 10 valorem taxation by one or more political subdivisions of this
- 11 state a person's inventory held for sale at retail, as defined by
- 12 general law.
- 13 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 17 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more
- 18 political subdivisions of this state a person's inventory held for
- 19 sale at retail."
