A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation tangible personal property
- 3 consisting of food or food products held by the owner of the

- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 7 adding Section 1-p to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 1-p. (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- 9 from ad valorem taxation tangible personal property consisting of
- 10 food or food products held by the owner of the property for sale at
- 11 retail.
- 12 (b) The legislature by general law may provide additional
- 13 eligibility requirements for an exemption authorized by this
- 14 section.
- 15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 19 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation tangible personal
- 20 property consisting of food or food products held by the owner of
- 21 the property for sale at retail."
