A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more political
- 3 subdivisions of this state property located near a public school
- 4 that is owned for the purpose of building low-income or
- 5 moderate-income housing.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-v to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 1-v.</u> (a) The legislature by general law may exempt from
- 10 <u>ad valorem taxation by one or more political subdivisions of this</u>
- 11 state property located near a public school that is owned by a
- 12 person for the purpose of building low-income or moderate-income
- 13 housing on the property.
- 14 (b) The legislature may provide additional eligibility
- 15 requirements for an exemption authorized by this section.
- 16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 18 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 20 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more
- 21 political subdivisions of this state property located near a public
- 22 school that is owned for the purpose of building low-income or
- 23 moderate-income housing."
