## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the governing
- 2 body of a political subdivision to limit the total amount of ad
- 3 valorem taxes that may be imposed by the political subdivision on
- 4 the residence homestead of certain lower-income individuals.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsection (s) to read as follows:
- 8 (s) The governing body of a political subdivision may
- 9 provide that the total amount of ad valorem taxes imposed by the
- 10 political subdivision on a residence homestead of a lower-income
- 11 <u>individual that is located in a homestead preservation district may</u>
- 12 <u>not exceed the amount of taxes the political subdivision imposed on</u>
- 13 the property in the year in which the individual first qualifies for
- 14 the limitation. The legislature by general law may define
- 15 "homestead preservation district" and may prescribe requirements
- 16 for eligibility for a tax limitation authorized by this subsection
- 17 and procedures for the administration of this subsection.
- 18 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 19 the Texas Constitution:
- TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 21 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 85th Legislature,
- 22 Regular Session, 2017, authorizing the governing body of a
- 23 political subdivision to limit the total amount of ad valorem taxes
- 24 that may be imposed by the political subdivision on the residence

- 1 <u>homestead of certain lower-income individuals.</u>
- 2 (b) Section 1-b(s), Article VIII, of this constitution
- 3 takes effect January 1, 2018, and applies only to a tax year
- 4 beginning on or after that date.
- 5 <u>(c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2019.</u>
- 6 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 10 governing body of a political subdivision to limit the total amount
- 11 of ad valorem taxes that may be imposed by the political subdivision
- 12 on the residence homestead of certain lower-income individuals."
