## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment guaranteeing the right to life
- 2 of unborn children and prohibiting abortion to the fullest extent
- 3 possible and to be known as the "Life at Conception provision of the
- 4 Texas Constitution's Bill of Rights".
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 19, Article I, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 19. DEPRIVATION OF LIFE, LIBERTY, ETC.; DUE COURSE OF
- 9 LAW. (a) No citizen of this State shall be deprived of life,
- 10 liberty, property, privileges or immunities, or in any manner
- 11 disfranchised, except by the due course of the law of the land.
- 12 (b) The term ''citizen of this State'' includes each member
- 13 of the species homo sapiens at all stages of life, including the
- 14 moment of fertilization, or other moment at which an individual
- 15 member of the human species comes into being.
- (c) The right to life guaranteed by the Constitution is
- 17 vested in each human being, born and unborn. Nothing in this Article
- 18 shall be construed to require the prosecution of any woman for the
- 19 death of her unborn child, a prohibition on in vitro fertilization,
- 20 or a prohibition on use of birth control or another means of
- 21 preventing fertilization.
- 22 <u>(d) To the fullest extent possible, abortion is prohibited</u>
- 23 in this State.
- (e) Subsections (c) or (d) do not prohibit a person from

- 1 receiving an abortion if:
- 2 (1) the case is a medical emergency as defined by
- 3 Section 171.002, Health and Safety Code; or
- 4 (2) the pregnancy was induced by cause or product of
- 5 <u>rape or incest.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 7, 2017.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 9 following proposition: "The constitutional amendment guaranteeing
- 10 the right to life from the moment of conception and, to the fullest
- 11 extent possible, prohibiting abortion."
