- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Lufkin and Angelina County are
- 2 gathering in Austin on February 15, 2017, to celebrate Lufkin and
- 3 Angelina County Day at the State Capitol; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Set among the pine and hardwood forests of East
- 5 Texas, this verdant area was first inhabited by the Caddo and
- 6 Atakapan people; the county is said to be named after a Hainai
- 7 Indian girl who aided Spanish missionaries in the early 1690s; and
- 8 WHEREAS, In 1801, a settler named Vicente Micheli purchased
- 9 five and a half leagues of land in the area from the chief of the
- 10 Bedias tribe; Anglo-American settlers began to arrive in 1820, and
- 11 the Mexican government issued land grants in the region in the
- 12 mid-1830s; after Texas independence, Angelina County was
- 13 established from part of Nacogdoches County in 1846, and Lufkin was
- 14 made county seat in 1892; and
- WHEREAS, Following the arrival of the first railroad in 1882,
- 16 lumber became the foundation of Angelina County's economy; by the
- 17 turn of the 20th century, the nation's need for southern pine
- 18 supported more than 15 lumber companies in the county; today,
- 19 lumber, paper, and the manufacturing of oil-field equipment
- 20 continue to be mainstays of the county's economy; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Residents and visitors alike enjoy the region's fine
- 22 recreational opportunities; the Angelina National Forest is a
- 23 favorite for hikers and campers, while the Sam Rayburn Reservoir is
- 24 known for its boating, fishing, and waterskiing; the county's

- 1 forestlands are also a prime habitat for many species of birds,
- 2 drawing bird-watchers from around the state and nation; and
- 3 WHEREAS, As the largest town and the seat of government,
- 4 Lufkin serves as the center of operations for many of the businesses
- 5 in the county, particularly those relating to lumber and wood
- 6 products; that industry's development is chronicled at the Texas
- 7 Forestry Museum, and the city includes several other notable
- 8 attractions, including the Museum of East Texas, the Ellen Trout
- 9 Zoo and Park, and the Medford Collection of American Western Art,
- 10 which exhibits the work of notable contemporary artists; in
- 11 addition, Lufkin is home to the main campus of Angelina College; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Celebrating their rich history as they work to build
- 13 an even brighter future, the citizens of Lufkin and Angelina County
- 14 may take great pride in the important role their unique region
- 15 continues to play in the story of the Lone Star State; now,
- 16 therefore, be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 18 Legislature hereby recognize February 15, 2017, as Lufkin and
- 19 Angelina County Day at the State Capitol and extend to the visiting
