16 WHEREAS, Following his retirement from the marines, 17 Mr. Buentello joined the staff at John Jay High, where he worked as 18 an in-school-suspension instructional assistant and volunteered 19 his time to coach football and track; and

WHEREAS, Of all his achievements, Mr. Buentello was most proud of his role as father to three sons, Ryan, Roman, and Sage, and husband to his beloved wife, Lisa; and
