WHEREAS, The Grand Prairie celebration of Cinco de Mayo not only pays tribute to a significant date in Mexican history but also assists area students through the raising of scholarship funds; this year's event would not be possible without the hard work and dedication of the Cinco de Mayo Committee and the sponsorship of a number of local businesses and organizations; and
