- 17 and its College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, from which an
- 18 estimated 25 percent of all African American pharmacists in the
- 19 country have graduated; TSU is also active in the Texas Legislative
- 20 Internship Program, which grants students the opportunity to gain
- 21 valuable experience in state government, alongside many
- 22 legislators who share personal ties to their alma mater; and
