RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Many proud Texans are visiting Austin on January 24,
 2017, to celebrate Texas Southern University Day at the State
 Capitol; and

WHEREAS, One of the nation's preeminent historically black colleges and universities, TSU was founded in 1927; it was designated as a special-purpose institution of higher education for urban programming by the Texas Legislature in 1973 and retains a steadfast commitment to innovative approaches that respond to the metropolitan environment; and

WHEREAS, The university now serves approximately 8,500 undergraduate and graduate students from around the world; it offers well over 100 baccalaureate, master's, and doctoral degree programs in 12 schools, including the Barbara Jordan--Mickey Leland School of Public Affairs, named after two alumni who served with distinction in the United States Congress; and

WHEREAS, TSU is noted for its Thurgood Marshall School of Law 16 and its College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, from which an 17 estimated 25 percent of all African American pharmacists in the 18 country have graduated; TSU is also active in the Texas Legislative 19 20 Internship Program, which grants students the opportunity to gain 21 valuable experience in state government, alongside many legislators who share personal ties to their alma mater; and 22

WHEREAS, Under the leadership of its 12th president,
Dr. Austin A. Lane, TSU has redoubled its efforts to increase
