RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Chicano History Week commences on February 2, 2017,
- 2 the 169th anniversary of the signing of the Treaty of Guadalupe
- 3 Hidalgo; and
- WHEREAS, A crucial document in the annals of both the United
- 5 States and Mexico, the 1848 treaty ended two years of war between
- 6 those nations; Mexico recognized the annexation of Texas by the
- 7 United States, accepted the Rio Grande as the state's southern
- 8 border, and gave up about half of its territory, including
- 9 modern-day California, Arizona, New Mexico, Texas, and parts of
- 10 Colorado, Nevada, and Utah, in exchange for \$15 million; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Approximately 80,000 Mexicans lived in the ceded
- 12 area at the time, and the vast majority chose to become United
- 13 States citizens; although the treaty granted protection of their
- 14 property and civil rights, and although subsequent adjudication in
- 15 Texas confirmed most of their claims, Mexican Texans in the area
- 16 between the Rio Grande and the Nueces River faced mounting pressure
- 17 and discrimination as the years passed and as more Anglos moved into
- 18 the region; within decades, Mexican Texans owned almost no land at
- 19 all; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Organized efforts to combat discrimination against
- 21 Latinos in Texas date to the early 1900s; in the 1960s and 1970s,
- 22 members of the Chicano movement joined the long struggle to win
- 23 social justice for Mexican Americans; composed largely of younger
- 24 Latinos, the movement focused attention on failed promises

- 1 contained in the Treaty of Guadalupe Hidalgo; at the same time, this
- 2 movement insisted on the value of Mexican culture and traditions
- 3 and gave impetus to the inclusion of the Mexican American
- 4 experience in discussions of U.S. history; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The contributions of Mexican Americans are integral
- 6 to the story of this nation, and by gaining a better understanding
- 7 of Chicano history, we deepen our appreciation of the rich heritage
- 8 that is shared by all Americans; now, therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 10 Legislature hereby recognize February 2-8, 2017, as Chicano History
- 11 Week and encourage all Texans to learn more about the important role
- 12 that Chicanos have played in the saga of the Lone Star State.
