1 WHEREAS, William A. Hyslop of Houston is retiring as
2 president and chief executive officer of the MD Anderson Services
3 Corporation and the MD Anderson Physicians Network on February 28,
4 2017, concluding a distinguished 30-year career in health care; and

5 WHEREAS, An alumnus of Trinity University, where he graduated
6 with a master's degree in health care administration in 1975,
7 Mr. Hyslop served for a decade as executive vice president and
8 chief operations officer of supporting organizations for The
9 University of Texas MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston before
10 being named to his current position in March 2009; and

11 WHEREAS, Over the course of his career, Mr. Hyslop has
12 overseen three general acute-care hospitals and seven nonprofit
13 community hospitals; he also established the Hyslop Group, a
14 national consulting firm that specialized in health care mergers
15 and acquisitions, strategic business development, and start-up
16 company formations; and

17 WHEREAS, William Hyslop has demonstrated remarkable vision
18 and skill throughout three decades as a health care administrator,
19 and he may indeed reflect with pride on his notable achievements and
20 contributions; now, therefore, be it
