RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Each day, countless people are exposed to sexually 2 explicit content through a wide range of media, and these consumers are often unaware of the health risks posed by such material; and 3 WHEREAS, Children are encountering pornography before their 4 5 teens, and this early exposure may lead to low self-esteem and body image disorders and an increased desire to engage in risky sexual 6

- behavior; and WHEREAS, Besides promoting unhealthy sexual expectations, 8 9 the adult entertainment industry produces media that objectify 10 women and children as well as depict rape and abuse; by associating 11 violence with sexual gratification, these materials perpetuate the 12 demand for sex trafficking, prostitution, sexual abuse images, and 13 child pornography; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Pornography has also been linked to such detrimental health effects as brain development complications, emotional and 15 medical afflictions, the inability to form and maintain intimate 16 relationships, and sexual addiction; these dangers not only affect 17 people on an individual level but also contribute to the 18 degradation of the family unit, frequently leading to marital 19 20 dissatisfaction and infidelity; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The ubiquity of pornography has resulted in a host of societal problems and potentially negative health effects, and 22 23 it is of paramount importance that our leaders tackle this critical public health issue; now, therefore, be it 24
