- 1 WHEREAS, Chief Darrell Lamond Allen of the Marlin Police
- 2 Department was posthumously honored with the Star of Texas Award on
- 3 September 12, 2016; and
- WHEREAS, Established by the 78th Texas Legislature in 2003,
- 5 the Star of Texas Awards annually recognize first responders who
- 6 have been seriously injured or killed in the line of duty;
- 7 recipients are selected by three advisory committees appointed by
- 8 the governor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Chief Allen passed away on November 10, 2015, at the
- 10 age of 43, after succumbing to injuries sustained while attempting
- 11 to arrest a man in a club in Temple; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Born in Galveston on January 17, 1972, to Lee and
- 13 Jeweline Allen, Darrell Allen graduated from Texas City High School
- 14 in 1990 and went on to earn an associate degree in criminal justice
- 15 from McLennan Community College in Waco; he later furthered his
- 16 education at Tarleton State University, where he completed a
- 17 bachelor's degree in criminal justice in 2015; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Chief Allen began his career in 1994 with the
- 19 Galveston County Sheriff's Office, and during his 21 years as a
- 20 peace officer, he served with the Alvin Independent School
- 21 District, the Hitchcock, Danbury, Arcola, and Lott Police
- 22 Departments, and the Constable's Office for Precinct 6 in Houston;
- 23 after accepting a position with the Marlin Police Department in
- 24 2005, he quickly rose through the ranks and was named assistant

- 1 chief in 2006; he became chief of police in 2009, and in that role,
- 2 he worked tirelessly to improve police-community relations and
- 3 juvenile safety in the Marlin area; and
- WHEREAS, A devoted family man, Chief Allen was the proud
- 5 father of 10 children, Issac, DarraMeisha, Jasey, Erin, Andrew,
- 6 Sheldon, Derrick, Josselyn, Jazzmin, and Melissa, and he was
- 7 further blessed with 6 treasured grandchildren; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Texans owe an immense debt of gratitude to the men
- 9 and women of the law enforcement profession who willingly place
- 10 themselves in harm's way to protect and serve the public, and the
- 11 presentation of a Star of Texas Award in honor of Darrell Allen
- 12 ensures that his dedication and sacrifice will not be forgotten;
