WHEREAS, Jesus G. Saenz of Benavides passed away on January
8, 2016, at the age of 77, bringing a great loss to his family and
many friends; and

WHEREAS, The son of Reynaldo and Eluteria Saenz, "Chick" Saenz was born in Benavides on July 2, 1938; he graduated from Benavides High School and went on to serve his country in the United States Marine Corps for three years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Saenz managed cattle ranches before embarking 8 on a four-decade career in law enforcement as a constable in the 9 Duval County Sheriff's Office; in 1972, he went to work for the 10 11 United States Department of Agriculture, and the following year, he 12 joined the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association as the first Hispanic member of its special rangers; commissioned through 13 the Texas Department of Public Safety and certified by Texas A&M 14 University--Kingsville, he investigated a wide range of crimes, 15 16 including cattle rustling, theft, poaching, and agricultural fraud; and 17

18 WHEREAS, Responsible for a six-county territory that 19 included the Mexican border between Laredo and Brownsville, 20 Mr. Saenz coordinated closely with a number of agencies on either 21 side of the Rio Grande to prevent the transport of stolen cattle; he 22 also taught livestock law and technology classes, and he helped 23 train officers across South Texas as a certified marksmanship 24 instructor; and
