- 10 Duval County Sheriff's Office; in 1972, he went to work for the
- 11 United States Department of Agriculture, and the following year, he

- 13 first Hispanic member of its special rangers; commissioned through
- 14 the Texas Department of Public Safety and certified by Texas A&M
- 15 University--Kingsville, he investigated a wide range of crimes,
- 16 including cattle rustling, theft, poaching, and agricultural
- 17 fraud; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Responsible for a six-county territory that
- 19 included the Mexican border between Laredo and Brownsville,
- 20 Mr. Saenz coordinated closely with a number of agencies on either
- 21 side of the Rio Grande to prevent the transport of stolen cattle; he
- 22 also taught livestock law and technology classes, and he helped
- 23 train officers across South Texas as a certified marksmanship
