16 later in life, he was blessed with eight grandchildren; and

17           WHEREAS, A man of strong religious faith, *Mr. Ochoa* attended  
18 *St. Paul's Catholic Church*; he treasured the time he spent with his  
19 family, and he in turn delighted his loved ones with his hearty  
20 sense of humor; and

21           WHEREAS, Possessed of a warm and generous nature, *Ciro Ochoa*  
22 earned the respect and admiration of all who were privileged to know  
23 him, and he will forever be a source of inspiration to those he  
24 leaves behind; now, therefore, be it
