RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas Forestry Association is sponsoring a 2 seedling giveaway on March 1, 2017, in an effort to promote public 3 awareness of working forests and the importance of our state's 4 timber resources; and

5 WHEREAS, Each year, family forest owners and corporate 6 landowners plant 75 million seedlings to help maintain sustainable 7 forests for future generations of Texans; and

8 WHEREAS, The forest sector in East Texas covers 12 million 9 acres and generates more than 138,000 jobs, \$8.1 billion in annual 10 labor income, and a total economic impact of over \$31.9 billion, 11 making timber a valuable agricultural commodity statewide; and

12 WHEREAS, Founded in 1914 by a group of dedicated conservationists, the Texas Forestry Association is a nonprofit 13 organization of some 3,000 landowners, business leaders, and other 14 professionals united by a common goal to advance forestry, promote 15 16 conservation practices, and support and protect the interests of the working forests of Texas; TFA offers programs such as the 17 Sustainable Forestry Initiative and Tree Farm certifications to 18 educate the public and encourage reforestation, with the 19 understanding that best management practices are essential for 20 productive forests; and 21

22 WHEREAS, The Texas Forestry Association has tirelessly 23 worked to ensure that abundant forests remain a dependable resource 24 for the citizens of Texas, and under the able leadership of current
