- WHEREAS, Once a stop on the San Benito and Rio Grande Valley
- 5 Railway, also known as "the Spiderweb Railroad," Alton was founded
- 6 in 1911 by citizens from Alton, Illinois, and officials of the Alton
- 7 Illinois Railroad; the town was known for its quarries, which
- 8 produced caliche for use in countless construction projects in
- 9 parts north; and
- 10 WHEREAS, The people of Alton voted to incorporate under a
- 11 general rule charter in 1978; 28 years later, the city adopted a
- 12 home rule charter; and
- 13 WHEREAS, The community selected as its motto "City on the
- 14 Grow," and it has indeed prospered in recent years; in 2000, it was
- 15 home to about 4,100 Texans, and in 2016, U.S. Census estimates
- 16 placed the population at some 15,500; more than 80 percent of
- 17 householders are homeowners, well above the national average;
- 18 recent years have seen the opening of numerous new businesses, and
- 19 the city completed construction of the fire station as well as a
- 20 number of major infrastructure projects; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Alton may take great pride in its heritage of hard
- 22 work as it builds toward a bright and promising future; now,
