- 1 WHEREAS, Many proud citizens of Lamar County are visiting the
- 2 State Capitol on March 7-9, 2017, to celebrate the role this
- 3 Northeast Texas county has played in the annals of the Lone Star
- 4 State; and
- 5 WHEREAS, At the time of the Republic of Texas, present-day
- 6 Lamar County was located within the boundaries of Red River County;
- 7 population growth led the Fifth Congress of the republic to
- 8 establish Lamar County on December 17, 1840, and the current
- 9 boundaries were drawn 30 years later when a portion of land was
- 10 carved out for the creation of Delta County; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Lamar County's namesake was the fourth president of
- 12 the Republic of Texas, Mirabeau B. Lamar; the small settlement of
- 13 Lafayette was the first county seat, and Mount Vernon later served
- 14 briefly in that capacity until the town of Paris was founded on 50
- 15 acres donated by George W. Wright; Paris has served as the county
- 16 seat since 1844; and
- 17 WHEREAS, At the turn of the century, Lamar County remained
- 18 primarily rural, and although the population of Paris had grown to
- 19 more than 9,000, no other community exceeded 1,000 residents; the
- 20 industrial economy gradually began to make gains on agriculture in
- 21 the 20th century as people moved into towns and smaller
- 22 communities, and Paris played an increasingly important role in the
- 23 economy of Northeast Texas; and
- WHEREAS, Today, Paris is a regional hub of retail trade,

- 1 farming, and medical care and home to Fortune 500 companies
- 2 Campbell Soup Company, Kimberly-Clark Corporation, and NextEra
- 3 Energy Resources; the city is located within an excellent
- 4 multimodal transportation network, and in addition to numerous food
- 5 and consumer goods manufacturing plants, it is home to distribution
- 6 centers that serve the entire nation; and
- WHEREAS, Quality of life in Paris is enhanced by Paris Junior
- 8 College and several excellent independent school districts and by
- 9 such beautiful recreation areas as Wade Park, Lake Gibbons, Lake
- 10 Crook, and the Sam Bell Maxey State Historic Structure; every
- 11 summer, citizens enjoy the 12-mile Tour de Paris bike race and
- 12 concerts by the Paris Municipal Band, the oldest such ensemble in
- 13 the state; landmarks include the Culbertson Fountain in the
- 14 historic district, named "the prettiest plaza in the State of
- 15 Texas" by Texas Monthly magazine, and the "third largest Eiffel
- 16 Tower in the Second Largest Paris," a 65-foot-tall monument
- 17 constructed by local workers and capped, appropriately, with a
- 18 cowboy hat; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Lamar County is one of the Lone Star State's great
- 20 treasures, and it is indeed a pleasure to honor its residents as
- 21 they look forward to a bright and promising future; now, therefore,
- 22 be it

- 24 Legislature hereby recognize March 7-9, 2017, as Lamar County Days
- 25 at the State Capitol and extend to the delegation sincere best
- 26 wishes for a meaningful and memorable stay in Austin.
