R E S O L U T I O N

4 Program recognizes high school students throughout the country for
5 their academic excellence; commended students are chosen on the
6 basis of their Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship
7 Qualifying Test scores, with honorees placing among the top five
8 percent of the approximately 1.6 million individuals who take the
9 examination each year; and
