R E S O L U T I O N

12 graduated from Eldorado High School in 1972 and continued her
13 education at Angelo State University; after completing her degree,
14 she accepted a position with the First National Bank of Eldorado,
15 where she has worked for the past 27 years; she currently serves as

17 WHEREAS, In all her endeavors, Ms. Snelson enjoys the love
18 and support of her husband of more than four decades, Stephen
19 Snelson, and her life has been further enriched by her son, Casey,
20 her daughter, Blake, and her four grandchildren; and

22 able and dedicated efforts of our public servants, and Jeanne
23 Snelson may indeed take well-deserved pride in her record of
24 achievement; now, therefore, be it
