R E S O L U T I O N

4 a half; and

11 College on a football scholarship; while still in his teens, he also
12 joined the Army Reserve, where he rose to the rank of sergeant; he
13 went on to enjoy a successful four-decade-long career at the
14 Commercial Bank of Mason and ultimately retired as vice president;

17 support of a loving family that includes his wife of more than half
18 a century, Johanna, as well as their three children and eight

22 deep concern for the public interest, and he may indeed reflect with
23 pride on all that he has accomplished in behalf of his fellow
