WHEREAS, This dynamic entrepreneur chose Laredo as the place for his next venture, Taco Palenque, which opened in 1987; the Taco Palenque chain has since expanded throughout South Texas, and in 2005 Mr. Ochoa made his first foray into full-service restaurants with the establishment of Palenque Grill, a brand that today includes locations in Laredo, McAllen, and San Antonio; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ochoa is supported in all his endeavors by his loving wife, Flérida, and he has had the pleasure of seeing his children and grandchildren join him in his ventures; his accomplishments as an entrepreneur have contributed to the creation of thousands of jobs in Mexico and in the United States, and in 2011 he had the honor of being named the BusinessPerson of the Year by the Laredo Chamber of Commerce; and
