- 1 WHEREAS, A distinguished delegation from South Texas is
- 2 visiting Austin on February 7, 2017, to celebrate Rio Grande Valley
- 3 Day at the State Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, Enjoying a strategic location on the Gulf of Mexico
- 5 and along the Mexican border, the Rio Grande Valley was an important
- 6 ranching region when Texas became the nation's 28th state in 1845;
- 7 over time, the economy shifted from ranching to agriculture, and
- 8 the Valley became the state's center of citrus and vegetable
- 9 production; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Industry flourished in the 1960s, and the region
- 11 contributed significantly to the tremendous increase in commerce
- 12 across the U.S.-Mexico border; with over 800,000 trucks, 11.5
- 13 million cars, and 5.8 million pedestrians crossing its ports of
- 14 entry, the Rio Grande Valley is a powerhouse that accounts for more
- 15 than \$1.3 billion in goods and services added to the economy of the
- 16 Lone Star State each day; and
- WHEREAS, The Valley has over 1.5 million residents, and local
- 18 and state officials have focused on the need to expand access to
- 19 higher education, strengthen the workforce, and introduce
- 20 programs, such as SpaceX, which partnered with The University of
- 21 Texas Rio Grande Valley to create STARGATE, a program that enables
- 22 students to be involved in all aspects of space missions;
- 23 furthermore, in July 2016, the new UTRGV Medical School enrolled
- 24 its first class of 55 medical students; and
