RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The City of Dallas lost an esteemed civic leader 2 with the passing of former Dallas Independent School Board president Hollis Brashear on February 5, 2016, at the age of 81; and 3 WHEREAS, Born in 1935, Hollis Brashear grew up in southern 4 5 Dallas during segregation; he spent summers as a boy picking cotton to help support his family and worked as a janitor at Prairie View 6 7 A&M University while completing his bachelor's degree in civil engineering; subsequently, he completed a master's degree at 8 9 Oklahoma State University; and WHEREAS, Mr. Brashear was commissioned 10 as second 11 lieutenant in the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and commanded a 12 combat engineer company near the demilitarized zone in Korea; he went on to serve in France and in the Vietnam War, earning many 13 14 decorations, among them two Bronze Stars; in 1979, he concluded a distinguished military career that spanned 21 years and returned to 15 16 his hometown, where he served as director of the City of Dallas Building Services Department; he also managed the Dallas office of 17 the Williams, Russell, and Johnson engineering firm and founded HNB 18 Consulting Engineers; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Mr. Brashear won a seat on the Dallas ISD board in 21 1992 and became a strong voice for the educational needs of minority children; he was twice elected president and provided calm 22 23 leadership during a contentious period; moreover, he was a mentor 24 and role model to other African American public officials; further

- 1 benefiting his community, he gave of his time and expertise to such
- 2 organizations as the Oak Cliff Chamber of Commerce, The University
- 3 of Texas at Dallas development board, the Dallas County Appraisal
- 4 District board, and the Dallas Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha
- 5 Fraternity; and
- 6 WHEREAS, After retiring from the school board in 2006,
- 7 Mr. Brashear remained active in educational matters while serving
- 8 as the caregiver for his beloved wife, Minnie, who passed away in
- 9 2014; he was the devoted father of Enez Brashear and Teresa
- 10 Brashear-Briscoe; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Hollis Brashear made a meaningful difference in the
- 12 lives of his loved ones and fellow citizens alike, and he will be
- 13 remembered with admiration and affection by all who were fortunate
- 14 enough to know him; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 16 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Hollis Brashear and
- 17 extend deepest sympathy to those who mourn his passing; and, be it
