WHEREAS, The daughter of Lino Edward Cuellar and Francisca Flores Cuellar, the former Bertha Cuellar was born in Floresville on November 21, 1917; she moved with her family to San Antonio as a young girl and went on to graduate from Brackenridge High School; and

9 WHEREAS, She married Henry B. Gonzalez in 1940, and the 10 couple became the proud parents of four sons, Henry, Charles, 11 Stephen, and Frank, and four daughters, Rose Mary, Bertha, 12 Genevieve, and Anna; when her children were young, Mrs. Gonzalez 13 was active in the PTA and served as a Cub Scout den mother; and

WHEREAS, While raising her family, Mrs. Gonzalez also shone as "campaigner in chief" for her husband, who became the state's first Mexican American congressman; she shared his deep commitment to social justice and played a crucial role in his long career in public service, providing wise counsel as well as tireless support; he often referred to her as his "secret weapon"; and

20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Gonzalez was happiest with a house full of 21 people, especially youngsters, and she rejoiced in a large family 22 that grew to include 21 grandchildren and 29 great-grandchildren; 23 following the death of Congressman Gonzalez in November 2000, Mrs. 24 Gonzalez demonstrated tremendous grace and resilience, and she
