- 10 couple became the proud parents of four sons, Henry, Charles,
- 11 Stephen, and Frank, and four daughters, Rose Mary, Bertha,

- 17 to social justice and played a crucial role in his long career in

- 19 he often referred to her as his "secret weapon"; and
- 20 WHEREAS, Mrs. Gonzalez was happiest with a house full of
- 21 people, especially youngsters, and she rejoiced in a large family
- 22 that grew to include 21 grandchildren and 29 great-grandchildren;
- 23 following the death of Congressman Gonzalez in November 2000, Mrs.
- 24 Gonzalez demonstrated tremendous grace and resilience, and she
