1 WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Building Owners and Managers
2 Association are gathering in Austin on February 22, 2017, to
3 celebrate Texas BOMA Advocacy Day at the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Established in 1937 as the state federated
5 organization of BOMA International, Texas BOMA represents the
