R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The members of Oak Hill Missionary Baptist Church in
2 Houston are joining together on May 7, 2017, to honor Dr. Andrew M.
3 Landry Sr. for 10 years of dedicated service to that congregation;
4 and

5 WHEREAS, Long affiliated with the church, Dr. Landry was
6 licensed to preach in 1993 and ordained seven years later; he was
7 appointed pastor in 2007, the same year that he earned his doctoral
8 degree in divinity from the Inter-Baptist Theological Center in
9 Houston; he also holds doctorates from the Inter-Baptist
10 Theological Seminary in Louisiana and from the Conroe Theological
11 Institute; and

12 WHEREAS, Dr. Landry has served his faith in a number of
13 leadership positions, including dean for the Conroe Baptist
14 Theological Institute Houston Extension and president and dean of
15 Mt. Zion Travelers Seminary; in addition, he has been first vice
16 president of the American Progressive Baptist Association of Texas
17 and dean of the Union Baptist District Association of Texas; he has
18 also volunteered as a chaplain for the Texas Department of Criminal
19 Justice, and he has taught at both the Open Door Mission homeless
20 shelter and the Canal Street Apartments for low-income adults; and

21 WHEREAS, This inspiring clergyman has led Oak Hill Missionary
22 Baptist Church with conviction and compassion, and he has earned
23 the lasting respect and admiration of his congregants as well as
24 members of the greater community; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
2 Legislature hereby honor Dr. Andrew M. Landry Sr. for his
3 outstanding decade-long tenure with Oak Hill Missionary Baptist
4 Church and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success
5 with his important work; and, be it further

7 prepared for Dr. Landry as an expression of high regard by the Texas
8 House of Representatives.
