## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The volunteers, staff, and board members who make up 2 the Texas Court Appointed Special Advocates organization are 3 gathering in Austin on February 16, 2017, for CASA Day at the State 4 Capitol; and

5 WHEREAS, Texas CASA is part of a national volunteer movement 6 begun in the 1970s that enlists community volunteers to serve as 7 court advocates for abused and neglected children; these volunteers 8 research the child's situation, provide critical information and 9 recommendations to judges about what is best for the child, and help 10 ensure that children in the foster care system find safe, permanent 11 homes as soon as possible; and

WHEREAS, The first CASA program in Texas began in Dallas more than 35 years ago, and Texas CASA was formed in 1989; the organization provides funding, training, coordination, and assistance to 72 local CASA programs statewide that last year engaged more than 9,100 volunteers, who gave life-changing advocacy, help, and encouragement to nearly 28,000 children and young people in state care; and

WHEREAS, CASA volunteers help to give children in the foster care system hope for a better future and provide courts with information they need to make well-informed decisions in child protective services cases, and their efforts help to ensure that the system functions as intended; all those associated with CASA are truly deserving of recognition for their service to the State of
