15 playing the four-string banjo, guitar, ukulele, keyboard, and
16 harmonica; in his spare time, he took part in a number of hobbies
17 that included banjo repair, woodworking, and crocheting; and

18 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Mosier enjoyed the love
19 and support of his wife, the former Diane Evans, with whom he shared
20 more than four decades; he was the devoted father of four children,
21 Tammy, Laura, David, and Carli, and with the passing years, he had
22 the pleasure of welcoming into his family seven grandchildren,
23 Catie, Natalie, Amanda, Trinity, Nova, Max, and Raiden, and a
24 great-grandson, Henry; and

1 WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Bubba Mosier
2 will remember the way he touched their lives with his warmth and
3 delightful sense of humor, and he will forever hold a treasured
4 place in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
