1 WHEREAS, Residents of Wise County are visiting Austin on

February 21, 2017, to celebrate Wise County Day at the State

WHEREAS, Located in the northwestern part of the state, Wise

5 County was established on January 23, 1856; the county was carved

6 out of Cooke County by legislative act and named in honor of Henry

7 A. Wise, a U.S. congressman from Virginia who had supported the

8 annexation of Texas; at the same time as it created Wise County, the

9 legislature decreed that its county seat be established within five

10 miles of the county's center, and two years later that new community

11 became known as Decatur, after the naval hero Stephen Decatur; and

12 WHEREAS, The eastern fork of the Chisholm Trail passed near

Decatur during the latter half of the 19th century, and the town

14 prospered as a shipping point and market for local farmers; today,

15 it is a center for natural gas production, specialty carbon and

16 graphite manufacturing, and health care, as well as marketing and

17 processing for area agribusiness; and

18 WHEREAS, Decatur is also home to some of the best

19 professional rodeo cowboys and bull riders in the world; among the

20 champions who live or train in the community are three-time

21 Professional Bull Riders World Champion Silvano Alves, PBR World

22 Champions Mike Lee and Guilherme Marchi, PBR Rookies of the Year

23 Joao Ricardo Vieira and Kaique Pacheco, and nine-time National

24 Finals Rodeo finalist steer wrestler K. C. Jones, as well as the

- 1 most decorated rodeo cowboy of all time, with 23 world
- 2 championships and 13 all-around titles, Trevor Brazile; the famed
- 3 Cooper family of rodeo cowboys also lives in Decatur, including the
- 4 patriarch and Texas Rodeo Hall of Famer Roy Cooper; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Visitors are drawn by such historic attractions as
- 6 the Waggoner Mansion, the Wise County Heritage Museum, the Wise
- 7 County Veterans Park, and the pink granite Wise County Courthouse,
- 8 which was completed in 1896; Wise County is home to a variety of
- 9 recreational opportunities provided by Lake Bridgeport, Eagle
- 10 Mountain Lake, and the Caddo-Lyndon B. Johnson National Grasslands;
- 11 in addition, area residents commemorate their heritage with the
- 12 annual Butterfield Stage Days Festival in May, the Wise County Old
- 13 Settlers Reunion in July, and the Chisholm Trail Days and Western
- 14 Heritage Festival in September; and
