R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The residents of Lewisville lost an admired civic
2 leader with the passing of city council member Leroy Vaughn on
3 February 1, 2017, at the age of 70; and

4 WHEREAS, Leroy Vaughn graduated with a bachelor's degree in
5 political science and business from the University of North Texas
6 and a master's degree in public affairs from The University of Texas
7 at Austin; he subsequently enjoyed a career with the City of Davis,
8 California, that spanned nearly two decades, working as a
9 firefighter, fire inspector, arson investigator, and building
10 inspector; and

11 WHEREAS, After relocating to Lewisville, Mr. Vaughn served
12 the community as a member of the Transportation Board, the
13 Community Development Block Grants Advisory Committee, and the 2010
14 Goals Committee, and he also volunteered as a benefits counselor
15 for the Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Vaughn was elected as the Place 1 representative
17 on the Lewisville City Council in 2011, and during his time in
18 office, he held the positions of mayor pro tem and deputy mayor pro
19 tem; moreover, he represented the municipal government in the
20 National League of Cities, where he was a member of the Finance,
21 Administration, and Intergovernmental Relations Steering
22 Committee, and he was appointed to the Emergency Preparedness
23 Planning Council for the North Central Texas Council of
24 Governments; in addition to his work as a public official, he was

1 the owner of Voninamillion Home Solutions, a real estate investment
2 company; and

3 WHEREAS, Deeply dedicated to his community, Leroy Vaughn made
4 a meaningful difference in the lives of his fellow citizens, and his
5 achievements will be a continuing source of inspiration to all who
6 had the good fortune to know him; now, therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
8 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of the Honorable Leroy
9 Vaughn and extend sincere condolences to all who mourn his passing;
10 and, be it further

11 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be

13 Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Leroy
14 Vaughn.
