3 a perfect score on the Advanced Placement Computer Science A Exam in  
4 2016; and

5           WHEREAS, Administered by the College Board, AP tests allow  
6 high school students to earn college credit by reaching a threshold  
7 score on the test; out of the more than 58,000 students worldwide  
8 who took the AP Computer Science A Exam in 2016, only 10 students  
9 got perfect marks; and

10           WHEREAS, The son of proud parents Michael and Maria Padilla,  
11 Miguel Padilla is a senior at Harmony School of Innovation, which he  
12 has attended since fourth grade; he hopes to attend the  
13 Massachusetts Institute of Technology and pursue a career  
14 researching artificial intelligence and machine learning; and

15           WHEREAS, Mr. Padilla credits his computer science teacher,  
16 Angelica Garcia, for setting the high academic standards that have  
17 helped him to excel; after he received his perfect score, he  
18 presented Ms. Garcia with a signed copy with the inscription, "I  
19 couldn't let you down, not even one point"; and

20           WHEREAS, This significant achievement has earned Miguel  
21 Padilla the respect and admiration of his teachers and classmates,  
22 and his exceptional scholastic ability and commitment to excellence  
23 are opening the way to a bright and promising future for this  
24 outstanding young Texan; now, therefore, be it
