1 WHEREAS, Members of the Young Republicans of Magnolia High
2 Schools are visiting the State Capitol on March 13, 2017, to learn
3 more about the legislative process; and

4 WHEREAS, A chapter of the National Teen Age Republicans and
5 High School Republicans of Texas, the club includes students from
6 both Magnolia and Magnolia West High Schools; the members strive to
7 educate others about the political process and the ideals of the
8 Republican Party, and they support local and national candidates
