16 WHEREAS, At the age of 19, while on vacation in England, she 17 met an American soldier, Richard Gay, and they married and moved to 18 Miami before settling in Houston; she later married Stephen Bencze; 19 her family has grown through the years to include 6 children, 18 20 grandchildren, and 6 great-grandchildren, and she maintains close 21 ties to her many relatives in France; in her free time, she is an 22 avid reader of histories and literary classics; and
