RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, The observance of National Healthcare Decisions
- 2 Week from April 16 to 22, 2017, is designed to raise awareness of
- 3 the importance of advance care planning; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Although the nation has made great strides in
- 5 providing end-of-life care, it has fallen short in ensuring that
- 6 terminally ill patients receive care that is in keeping with their
- 7 values, goals, and preferences; a 2014 report by the Institute of
- 8 Medicine called for significant reforms in this regard, emphasizing
- 9 that all individuals should have the opportunity to actively
- 10 participate in decisions about the care they receive in the last
- 11 stages of life; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Individuals can communicate their end-of-life
- 13 desires to health care providers by means of advance directives,
- 14 including living wills and durable powers of attorney; such
- 15 documents are a gift to loved ones, saving them from the struggle of
- 16 trying to divine wishes that were never expressed; and
- WHEREAS, Many Texans have not prepared advance directives,
- 18 and the problem is particularly acute among Mexican Americans and
- 19 other minority populations; in Hidalgo County, which is more than
- 20 90 percent Hispanic, advocates are working to encourage timely
- 21 discussions of end-of-life wishes and to demystify the planning
- 22 process through La Conversacion Valiosa, a program presented in
- 23 conjunction with the Texas Health Institute; and
- 24 WHEREAS, This special week reminds Texans that the process of

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- 1 communicating patient preferences should be initiated at the
- 2 earliest possible stage and that advance care directives should be
- 3 updated periodically to offer peace of mind to patients and loved
- 4 ones alike; now, therefore, be it
- 5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas
- 6 Legislature hereby recognize April 16 to 22, 2017, as National
- 7 Healthcare Decisions Week and commend all those associated with La
- 8 Conversacion Valiosa for their efforts to facilitate advance care
- 9 planning.
