1           WHEREAS, Matt Lohmeier of the Corpus Christi Clergy Alliance  
2 and Jesse Elizondo of the Homeless Issues Partnership are working  
3 together to end chronic homelessness in Corpus Christi, and their  
4 efforts are truly worthy of recognition; and

5           WHEREAS, According to the Homeless Issues Partnership,  
6 hundreds of people currently experience chronic homelessness in  
7 Corpus Christi; while many individuals can be helped through  
8 transitional housing initiatives, others, for a variety of reasons,  
9 are not well served by such programs; and

10           WHEREAS, Mr. Lohmeier and Mr. Elizondo advocate for an  
11 approach that benefits all those in need of help; they support the  
12 housing-first model, which seeks to rehouse homeless individuals as  
13 quickly as possible as a means of restoring their dignity and which  
14 only subsequently addresses behavioral issues and social  
15 reintegration; the two civic leaders are focused on ending  
16 homelessness in Corpus Christi by 2019; and

17           WHEREAS, Matt Lohmeier and Jesse Elizondo are committed to  
18 addressing a crisis that blights the lives of some of Corpus  
19 Christi's most vulnerable residents, and through their leadership  
20 in this effort, they are providing real hope to those who are  
21 directly affected and making an immeasurable contribution to the  
22 community at large; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 85th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby honor Matt Lohmeier and Jesse Elizondo for their
