RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Technology industry leaders from some of the 2 nation's most dynamic start-ups and iconic companies are gathering 3 at the State Capitol on March 1, 2017, to celebrate the continued 4 growth of the innovation economy in Texas; and

5 WHEREAS, Long at the forefront of science, Texas is known for 6 groundbreaking developments, such as those achieved by NASA's 7 Apollo Program at the Lyndon B. Johnson Space Center in Clear Lake, 8 as well as the advanced research undertaken by public universities 9 and the disruptive start-up culture that has taken hold in Austin, 10 San Antonio, Houston, Dallas, and other locations; and

WHEREAS, The technology industry encompasses more than 35,000 businesses across Texas, from cutting-edge entrepreneurs to established industry leaders; the sector employs more than 600,000 people, representing the second-largest workforce of its kind in the country; and
